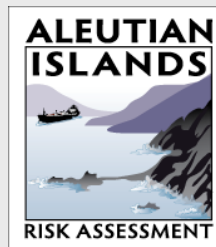


Aleutian Islands Risk Assessment: Advisory Panel Meeting
