

## **Aleutian Island Risk Assessment (AIRA) Status Report: March 2010**



### **Meetings/Teleconferences**

- The Management/Facilitation and Risk Analysis Teams met four times via teleconference and in-person to discuss the projects status and response to comments on the draft Traffic and Spill Study reports. On March 1<sup>st</sup>, Management Team members discussed and approved comment reports submitted from the Advisory Panel and Technical Peer Review Panel. Members of the Technical Peer Review Panel participated in the March 1<sup>st</sup> teleconference to explain their rationale regarding their consent comments and answer any questions raised by Management Team members. The comment reports were forwarded to the Risk Analysis Team for review on March 3<sup>rd</sup>. On March 16<sup>th</sup> a teleconference was held to discuss the Risk Analysis Team's responses to all comments received and any potential budget impacts. The Management Team met again on March 18<sup>th</sup> to consolidate their reply to comments. The Management Team members approved the comment documents on March 30<sup>th</sup> for the Risk Analysis Team to implement recommended changes.
